Summary of findings

Overall summary

Richmond Hall Care Home provides accommodation, nursing and personal care to a maximum of 64 people aged 65 and over. At the time of the inspection there were 39 people living at the service.

We found the following examples of good practice.

- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) such as masks, gloves and aprons were available to visiting professionals on entry to the building. A screening tool was completed prior to entry to ensure any visitors had not been exposed to Covid-19.
- People kept in touch with family members via telephone or video calls. Additional computer programmes had been purchased to allow relatives to log in and see photographs of what their family member had been doing.
- Where people or staff had received a positive Covid-19 test, the provider followed national guidance relating to self-isolation.
- Staff had received additional training in the use of PPE and were reminded of best practice daily through a staff messaging group.

Detailed findings

Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

As part of CQC's response to care homes with outbreaks of coronavirus, we are conducting reviews to ensure that the Infection Prevention and Control practice was safe and the service was compliant with IPC measures. This was a targeted inspection looking at the IPC practices the provider has in place.

This inspection took place on 16 November 2020 and was announced.
